Technical Memorandum (TM) 66 describes a Circular Economy's main aims, how it can be achieved and what it's practice will mean to the different branches of our industry like specifiers, manufacturers, contractors, and Facilities Managers.

The Circular Economy Assement Method for Manufacturing (CEAM-Make)'s list of 66 searching questions, the majority of which askfor back-up evidence, is split into four sections :
